

MASTER SERGEANT JACQUELINE S. WILGOSZ

MSgt Jacqueline S. Wilgosz currently serves as the Superintendent of Airfield Management, 161st Operations Support Squadron, Goldwater Air National Guard Base, Phoenix, Arizona. She is responsible for overseeing the execution of Airfield Management operations to support daily and global missions for the Arizona Air National Guard.

Sergeant Wilgosz's military career began in 1997 while assigned to the 182nd Airlift Wing. She worked a wide variety of positions in the wing with assignments to the 182nd Maintenance Group, first as an Aircraft Fuels Maintenance Specialist repairing various components of fuel tanks. In 2004 she was selected for a full time technician position as a Structural Maintenance Specialist conducting inspections and completing repairs on C-130 aircraft. In 2007 she cross trained into Survival Equipment where she inspected and repaired life-saving equipment. In 2008, the Survival Equipment career field merged with the Life Support career field which then became Aircrew Flight Equipment in the Operations Squadron. In 2015 she transferred to the 161st Air Refueling Wing where she worked in Aircrew Flight Equipment performing duties supporting KC-135's. In 2018 she cross trained to her current position in the Airfield Management section as the Superintendent. Additionally, she manages the Wing Airfield Driving Program, holds many additional duties



such as: Unit Resource Advisor AROWS Order Specialist, Government Travel Card Program Manager, and Top Three Treasurer. She has successfully completed three CENTCOM deployments in 2003, 2010 and 2016 and one PACOM deployment in 2016.
